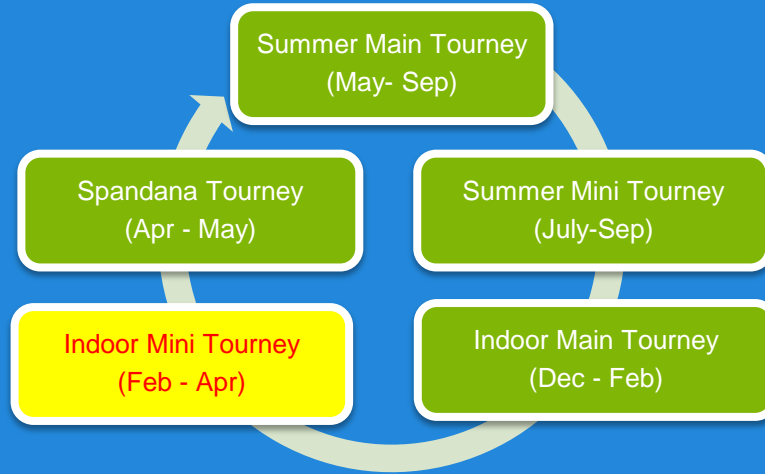

ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Tournament starts on Feb 22nd , 2016 (Monday)
- Ends on April 2nd or 3rd week
- Total of 19 matches
- All matches 13 overs
- Minimum 4 matches per team
- NO RESCHEDULE
- Practice Slots (\$105) – Team directly work with GTG
- Superover only for FINAL game

COMMON RULES

- Communication
 - WhatsApp vs Email
 - WhatsApp is not considered for record
- Financial Transactions
 - Chase QP or Cash App
 - No CASH or CHECK

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- Leagues matches
 - Group A, B and C – 3 Teams each
 - Semifinalist Seeded Teams from CICA Indoor 2016 will be distributed in each group by chit draw.
 - Remaining Teams will be distributed through random chits draw.
 - Round 1
 - Each team on group of 3 will play each other
 - Round 2
 - Based on Round 1 ranking, each team will play two matches against teams in other groups.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- **Round 2**

- Rank 1 from Round 1 from each group will play Rank 3 team from other two groups.
- Rank 2 from Round 1 from each group will play Rank 2 team from other two groups.
- Rank 3 from Round 1 from each group will play Rank 1 team from other two groups.

- **Final**

- After the completion of both Round 1 and 2, top ranked teams from both rounds by points and then by NRR will play Final.

ROSTER

- Max 15 members team
- \$25 per player for each replacement
- Player replacement only allowed in League stages
- Player must have played one league to qualify for Knock-out games.
- New addition/replacement can play a match only if Fee is paid and email notification is sent to CICA
- Deadline to Roster submission
 - Mar 9th 2016
 - Any changes after March 9th 11:59pm will require replacement fee.

MATCH RESCHEDULE/ DELAY

- **Delayed Matches**

- Captains are responsible for starting and completing the games on time. Umpires will help captains to enforce the timing as much as possible.
- CICA not responsible for matches not completed on time. Teams will have to book extra slot with GTG to complete the games.
- Any delayed game must be completed before each ROUND otherwise the point will be spilt.

- **Rescheduled Matches**

- CICA not responsible for RESCHEDULE games.
- Team will pay on their own for any RESCHEDULE and work directly with GTG.
- Umpiring will not be guaranteed and will not be penalized for reschedule games.
- Any reschedule games must produce result before League stage is completed.

MATCH RESCHEDULE

- **Superover**

- No superover rule in case of TIE during league stage
- Final match will follow Superover in case of TIE

- **Rescheduled Matches Round 1**

- Any rescheduled match must completed by March 24th
- Not completed Round 1 games will be considered ABANDONED and NO POINTS awarded.

- **Rescheduled Matches Round 2**

- Any rescheduled match must completed by April 2nd
- Not completed Round 2 games will be considered ABANDONED and NO POINTS awarded.

UMPIRING

- 4 umpires and 2hrs each for Each Team.
- Penalty for No-Show
 - Minus 1 Points and \$50 per umpire.
- No umpire exchanging allowed or entertained.
- Umpiring No-Show must be reported TWO CALENDAR DAYS after the match day. Must be notified via email and delayed report will not be honored.
- Player retired hurt rule
 - Both umpire must be convinced and agree for player's to exercise retired hurt rule. Player can only return as last wicket if retired hurt rule exercised.

UMPIRING

- Umpires must be on the ground on time and any delay beyond 15 minutes from the scheduled start time for the umpires will be considered “NO SHOW” and no show umpire rule will be followed.
- Fine for “NO SHOW” must be paid before the respective team’s very next game. If the fine is not paid before the game, captain will be SUSPENDED.
- Any suspended player is not allowed to play and violation of this rule will warrant the match being awarded to opposition team.
- Electronic media cannot be used for umpiring decision review.
- Additional clarifications...
 - Also it is important to note that “FREE HIT” rule applies for any NO BALL scenarios not just for over-stepping.
 - When the ball hits three times on the roof by the batsman that wicket does not belong to any bowler and please choose "hit ball twice" option.
